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NEWS	Risk	Consider Sepsis?
0-2		
3-5	<b>3 - THREAT!</b> Acute illness or unstable chronic disease?	<b>NEWS ≥3 + suspected new infection should lead to sepsis screening using the appropriate local tool</b>
6-8	<b>6 - SICK!</b> Likely to deteriorate rapidly	
≥9	<b>9 - NOW!</b> Immediately life threatening critical illness	

**CAUTION:** Frequency of observations can be increased at the discretion of the clinical team. Concern about a patient or difficulty obtaining any single parameter should lead to escalation, regardless of the score.

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
