Vaccine Uptake in Children in Wales COVER Annual report 2016



Data for the year ending 31st March 2016

Key points

- In 2015/16 uptake of all established routine immunisations in one year old children for Wales was over 95% for the eighth consecutive year. All Local Authority areas exceeded the 95% uptake target for the 5 in 1 immunisation in one year olds.
- Uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine was 93% at the first birthday representing uptake in the second cohort of children eligible for this new vaccine.
- Uptake of the first dose of MMR at 2 years remains above target at 95%.
- In 2015/16, 85% of children were up to date with recommended immunisations by their fourth birthday a decreased compared to the previous two years.
- Uptake of the second dose of MMR by 5 years of age was 92% compared to 93% in 2014/15, this reflects the declining trend seen over the previous five quarters.
- Uptake of pre-school 4 in 1 booster in five year old children was 92%.
- Uptake of one dose of Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine in girls turning 14 years of age during the 2015/16 School Year 9 was 90%. Uptake of two doses is currently 67%. This represents the first school year group to be offered the two dose schedule.

Findings

- 1. These results are for children living in Wales in March 2016 and reaching their first, second, fourth, fifth, 15th and 16th birthdays between 01/04/2015 and 31/03/2016. Current uptake of HPV vaccination¹ in girls in the 2015/16 School Year 9 (reaching their 14th birthday between 01/09/2015 and 31/08/2016) and uptake of MenC containing vaccine in children in the 2015/16 School Year 10 (reaching their 15th birthday between 01/09/2015 and 31/08/2016) is also presented.²
- 2. Annual uptake of the completed course of '5 in 1'3 vaccine, scheduled at 2, 3 and 4 months of age, in children reaching their first birthday remained stable at 96.6%. Uptake ranged by Health Board (HB) from 95.5% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 98.2% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by Local Authority (LA) from 95.0% (Newport) to 98.7% (Merthyr Tydfil). All 22 LAs achieved the 95% target (Figures 1, 2, 4, 6 and Tables 2, 3).
- **3.** Annual uptake of a completed one dose course of MenC⁴ vaccine in children reaching their first birthday this year was 97.4% ranging by HB from 96.2% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 98.7% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 95.8% (Cardiff) to 98.8% (Blaenau Gwent and Merthyr Tydfil) (Figures 1, 2 and Tables 2, 3).
- **4.** Uptake of a complete two dose primary course of pneumococcal conjugate vaccination (PCV2⁵) in children at one year of age was 96.4%, ranging by HB from 95.0% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 98.2% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 94.7% (Cardiff) to 98.7% (Merthyr Tydfil) (Figures 1, 2 and Table 3).

- 5. Uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine in children reaching their first birthday was 93.4% compared to 83.6% in the previous year. Uptake ranged by HB from 91.3% (Powys Teaching HB) to 97.2% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 90.1% (Monmouthshire) to 98.0% (Merthyr Tydfil) (Figure 2, Tables 2 and 3). This is the second group of children reported through the annual COVER scheme who would have been eligible to receive rotavirus vaccine.
- 6. Uptake of one dose of MMR⁶ by two years of age remained stable this year at 95.3% compared to 95.8% in the previous year. Uptake ranged by HB from 93.6% (Hywel Dda University HB) to 97.0% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 92.4% (Ceredigion) to 97.6% (Merthyr Tydfil). Four HBs achieved the target uptake of 95% for one dose of MMR by two years of age, and 13 out of 22 LAs exceeded the 95% target (Figures 1, 4 and 7 and Tables 2, 4).
- 7. Annual uptake of the final dose of Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCVf) by two years of age was 95.6%. Uptake by HB ranged from 94.0% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 97.3% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 93.3% (Ceredigion) to 97.7% (Blaenau Gwent) (Tables 2, 4).
- **8.** Annual uptake of the Hib/MenC⁷ booster by two years of age was 94.7%, ranging by HB from 92.3% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 97.0% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 91.5% (Cardiff) to 97.6% (Merthyr Tydfil) (Tables 2, 4).
- **9.** Coverage of the Hib/MenC booster in children by the time of their fourth birthday was 94.1% and ranged by HB from 91.3% (Powys Teaching HB) to 96.4% (Cwm Taf University HB) (Figure 2, Tables 1 and 5).
- **10.** This year, coverage of the '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV⁸ pre-school booster in children by four years of age was 88.2%, this ranged by HB from 82.5% (Aneurin Bevan University HB) to 92.1% (Betsi Cadwaladr University HB) (Figure 3, Tables 1 and 5).
- **11.** Coverage of a complete two dose course of MMR vaccine in children by four years of age was 87.7%, this ranged by HB from 83.4% (Aneurin Bevan University HB) to 90.7% (Abertawe Bro Morgannwg University HB) (Figure 3, Tables 1 and 5).
- **12.** The proportion of children who were up to date with their Hib/MenC booster, '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV pre-school booster and MMR vaccines by four years of age was 85.3%, a 0.9% decrease from 86.2% in 2014/15. (Figure 3, Tables 1 and 5). This ranged by HB from 80.0% (Aneurin Bevan University HB) to 89.5% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 74.4% (Newport) to 91.7% (Anglesey).
- 13. Annual uptake of two doses of MMR in children at five years of age was 91.6% this year, compared to 93.1% last year (Figures 1, 5, 8, Tables 2, 6), ranging by HB from 89.4% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 93.5% (Betsi Cadwaladr University HB). Coverage of one dose of MMR in children at five years of age was 96.8% and ranged by HB from 94.9% (Powys Teaching HB) to 98.0% (Cwm Taf University HB).
- **14.** Uptake of the '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV pre-school booster in children reaching their fifth birthday this year was 92.1%, compared to 93.4% in the previous year (Figures 5, 9, Tables 2, 6).
- 15. Coverage of one dose of HPV vaccine in girls in the 2014/15 School Year 8 (reaching their 14th birthday between 01/09/15 and 31/08/16) was 89.6%, ranging by HB from 83.7% (Powys Teaching HB) to 95.0% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 81.7% (Monmouthshire) to 95.6% (Rhondda Cynon Taf) (Table 7). Coverage of two doses of HPV vaccine in girls in the 2014/15 School Year 8 is currently 66.6%. This is the first group of girls to be offered the two dose course of HPV vaccination [4]. Vaccination sessions for the

- second dose of HPV vaccine in this group may not have been completed across all areas and will be expected to continue to increase until the end of the current school year.
- 16. Annual coverage of two doses of MMR in teenagers at 15 years of age was 88.5% (Table 8), ranging by HB from 83.5% (Powys Teaching HB) to 90.3% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 82.7% (Monmouthshire) to 93.8% (Caerphilly). Coverage of one dose of MMR in 15 year olds was 93.8%, ranging by HB from 89.7% (Powys Teaching HB) to 96.2% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 88.9% (Monmouthshire) to 97.3% (Caerphilly). A breakdown by sex indicates that 88.9% of girls had received a full (two MMR doses) course of immunisation against rubella this year and coverage of only one dose was 93.9%.
- **17.** National uptake of the Td/IPV⁹ teenage booster in children reaching 15 years of age in the year ending 31st March 2016 was 82.7%, an increase of 3.1% from 79.6% in the previous year (Table 8). Uptake ranged by HB from 75.8% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 91.4% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 74.0% (Cardiff) to 92.0% (Merthyr Tydfil).
- 18. Annual coverage of two doses of MMR in teenagers at 16 years of age was 89.4% (Tables 2, 9), ranging by HB from 86.0% (Powys Teaching HB) to 91.3% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 84.4% (Monmouthshire) to 93.6% (Wrexham). Annual coverage of one dose of MMR in 16 year olds was 94.4%, ranging by LA from 90.1% (Monmouthshire) to 97.8% (Torfaen and Caerphilly). A breakdown by sex indicates that 90.2% of girls had received a full (two MMR doses) course of immunisation against rubella this year and coverage of only one dose was 94.8%.
- **19.** National uptake of the Td/IPV teenage booster in children reaching 16 years of age in the year ending 31st March 2016 was 82.9% (Tables 2 and 9).
- 20. The teenage MenC booster was introduced at the start of the 2014/15 school year. Local arrangements for the delivery of this vaccine vary, with some Health Boards routinely offering it to 13-14 year olds and some to 14-15 year olds [1]. The majority of children reaching their 15th birthday between 01/09/15 and 31/08/16 (2015/16 School Year 9) would have received the single antigen teenage MenC booster, however a small number are recorded as having received the MenACWY vaccine. Uptake of MenC containing vaccine in this school year group is currently 82.1% (Table 10).
- 21. The relationship between deprivation and uptake was examined. The percentage of children who were up to date with their routine vaccinations by four years of age is presented broken down by Health Board and the national quintile of deprivation of the Lower Super Output Area (LSOA) in which the children reside (Figure 10 and Table 11). National quintiles of deprivation were calculated according to the LSOA rankings contained in the Welsh Index of Multiple Deprivation (WIMD 2014). For the data presented here, quintile five represents the most deprived quintile of LSOA and quintile one represents the least deprived quintile of LSOA. Deprivation rankings contained in the WIMD are relative, not absolute values and they refer to an overall composite measure of factors related to deprivation for the LSOA as a whole, not the individual circumstances of residents within the LSOA. Nationally, the percentage of children up to date with their routine immunisations by four years of age ranged from 89.1% in the least deprived quintile of LSOA to 81.9% in the most deprived quintile of LSOA. The difference in uptake between the least deprived quintile and the most deprived quintile was 7.2%, an increase from 6.7% in 2014/15 and 5.2% in 2013/14 (Figure 11).
- 22. Uptake of hepatitis B immunisation, extracted from the Public Health Wales All Wales Neonatal Hepatitis B immunisation database, is presented in Table 12. The database was developed to assist the Public Health Wales Health Protection Team in the monitoring and follow up of hepatitis B immunisation of babies born to hepatitis B positive mothers and to provide a source for statistics on uptake of hepatitis B immunisation in this group. of three doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their first birthday in the year ending 31st March 2016 was 98.3%. Uptake of four doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their second birthday in the year ending 31st March 2016 was 88.1%. Uptake of four doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their fifth birthday in the year ending 31st March 2016 was 95.0%.

Comment

During 2015/16 uptake of all established immunisations remain above 95% in children aged one year of age. However, there has been a decrease in uptake of some routine immunisations in older children, following a positive trend seen from 2006 to 2014/15.

This report contains rotavirus immunisation uptake figures for the second annual cohort of children reaching their first birthday, who would have been scheduled to receive the vaccine introduced from 1st July 2013 [2]. As expected, uptake of rotavirus vaccine has increased compared to the first year of vaccine introduction and is now approaching 95%.

The proportion of children who are up to date with their routine immunisations by four years of age has decreased, although regional uptake varies greatly, with three LAs achieving above 90%. Of all the immunisations that are included in this composite measure, uptake of the second dose of MMR saw the largest decrease followed by the Hib/MenC booster. Uptake of the '4 in 1' preschool booster remained stable. The gap in immunisation coverage between four year olds residing in the most and least deprived areas increased for the second year in a row, but remained lower than the 9% gap reported in 2012/13.

Uptake of two doses of MMR in 5 year olds has decreased by 1.5% this year compared to last year. This reflects the declining trend in two doses of MMR in this age group seen over the previous five quarters.

Uptake of the teenage booster against diphtheria, tetanus and polio increased further again this year, with a 3% increase compared to last year in 15 year olds. Uptake of one dose of MMR in 15 and 16 year olds was below the 95% target this year, and less than 90% of teenagers received the second dose of MMR. It is important that children in this age group are vaccinated before they leave school to attend college and later university.

This report provides uptake figures for the first routine group of girls to be offered a two dose course of HPV vaccination following recent change in the HPV vaccination programme in September 2014 [3]. Uptake of one dose of HPV was 90%, uptake of two doses will increase as further school immunisation sessions are reported on.

During the 2015/16 financial year the single antigen meningococcal group C vaccine was replaced with meningococcal ACWY vaccine in teenagers (with a phased catch-up campaign) there was also the addition of routine vaccination against meningococcal group B disease [4, 5]. Preliminary data for the uptake of MenACWY vaccine in children turning 16 years of age in the 2015/16 school year is 62%. Preliminary data for uptake of one dose of meningococcal group B vaccine in infants turning 6 months of age between 1st January 2016 and 31st March 2016 is 97%, uptake of two doses in this age group is 91%. Uptake figures for both of these vaccination programmes will be reported in future quarterly and annual COVER reports.





Figure 2. Summary of uptake rates for selected immunisations in resident children reaching their 1st, 2nd, 5th and 16th birthday between 01/04/2015 and 31/03/2016 and resident on 31/03/2016.




Figure 5. (a) Uptake of two doses of MMR vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 5th birthday between 01/04/15 and 31/03/16. **(b)** Uptake of 4 in 1 vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 5th birthday between 01/04/15 and 31/03/16.




Figure 6. Annual uptake of 5 in 1 vaccine by 1 year of age (2012 – 2016 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2015/16).




Figure 7. Annual uptake of 1 dose of MMR by 2 years of age (2012 – 2016 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2015/16).




Figure 8. Annual uptake of 2 doses of MMR by 5 years of age (2012 – 2016 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2015/16).




Figure 9. Annual uptake of the '4 in 1' pre-school booster by 5 years of age (2012 – 2016 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2015/16).




Figure 10. Percentage of children who are up to date with routine immunisations ¹² by four years of age, by quintile of deprivation of the Lower Super Output Area in which they reside. Vaccine uptake is presented for children reaching their 4th birthday between 01/04/2015 and 31/03/2016 and resident on 31/03/2016.





Figure 11. Percentage of children who are up to date with routine immunisations by four years of age during 2012-2016 financial years, by quintile of deprivation of the Lower Super Output Area in which they reside.
