Vaccine Uptake in Children in Wales COVER Annual Report 2017



Data for the year ending 31st March 2017

Key points

- In 2016/17 uptake of the '5 in 1' and pneumococcal conjugate vaccinations in 1 year old children in Wales was over 95% for the ninth consecutive year.
- Uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine was 94% at the first birthday representing uptake in the third annual cohort of children eligible for this vaccine.
- Uptake of two doses of MenB vaccine in those born during the eligible time period was 87%, reflecting a period of introduction and catch up.
- Uptake of the first dose of MMR at 2 years remains on target at 95%.
- Overall 85% of children were up to date with recommended immunisations by their fourth birthday, a decrease in this measure for the third year in a row.
- Uptake of the second dose of MMR by 5 years of age was 90% compared to 92% in 2015/16.
- Uptake of the pre-school '4 in 1' booster in five year old children was 93%.
- Uptake of one dose of Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine in girls turning 14 years of age during the 2016/17 school year was 87%. Uptake of two doses in girls turning 15 years of age was 86%.
- Coverage of two doses of MMR vaccine in teenagers turning 15 and 16 years of age during the 2016/17 school year was 87% and 89%, respectively.
- Uptake of MenACWY vaccine in teenagers turning 15 years of age during the 2016/17 school year, the first School Year 9 cohort to be offered the vaccine, was 80%.

Vaccination uptake findings

- 1. These results are for children living in Wales in March 2017 and reaching their first, second, fourth and fifth birthdays between 01/04/2016 and 31/03/2017. For the first time in the annual COVER report, uptake of vaccinations in those reaching 15 and 16 years of age have been presented by school year where they have previously been presented by financial year. In addition HPV vaccination in girls reaching 14 to 16 years of age in the 2016/17 school year are also presented.
- 2. Annual uptake of the completed course of '5 in 1'2 vaccine, scheduled at 2, 3 and 4 months of age, in children reaching their first birthday remained stable at 96.3%. Uptake ranged by health board (HB) from 95.0% (Hywel Dda HB) to 97.8% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by local authority (LA) from 94.3% (Pembrokeshire) to 98.4% (Blaenau Gwent). Twenty of the 22 LAs achieved the 95% target (Figures 1, 2, 4, 6 and Tables 2, 3).
- 3. Annual uptake of a completed one dose course of MenC³ vaccine in children reaching their first birthday this year was 94.4%. From the 1st July 2016 infants were no longer offered the MenC vaccination at 12 weeks of age [1]. Uptake may appear lower than in previous annual COVER reports as this is the last group of children to be offered MenC vaccination at this age; and children who missed scheduled vaccinations may not have been caught-up after 1st July.

² DTaP/IPV/Hib vaccine protects against diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (Whooping Cough), polio and Hib infection.

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¹ HPV vaccination protects girls against cervical cancer associated with HPV types 16 and 18.

³ MenC vaccine protects against meningitis caused by meningococcus group C infection. Children reaching one year of age would have been offered one dose of MenC vaccine at 3 months of age. From the 1st July 2016 infants were no longer offered the MenC vaccination at 12 weeks of age.

- 4. Uptake of a complete two dose primary course of pneumococcal conjugate vaccination (PCV2⁴) in children at one year of age was 96.2%, ranging by HB from 94.8% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 97.9% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 94.3% (Pembrokeshire) to 99.0% (Blaenau Gwent) (Figures 1, 2 and Table 3).
- 5. Uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine in children reaching their first birthday was 94.1% compared to 93.4% in the previous year. Uptake ranged by HB from 92.6% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 96.3% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 91.1% (Ceredigion) to 97.2% (Merthyr Tydfil) (Figure 2, Tables 2, 3). This is the third group of children reported through the annual COVER scheme who would have been eligible to receive rotavirus vaccine.
- Uptake of two doses of meningococcal serotype B vaccination (MenB⁵) in children at one year of age was 80.2%, ranging by HB from 78.6% (Hywel Dda University HB and Powys Teaching HB) to 81.5% (Abertawe Bro Morgannwg University HB) and by LA from 77.3% (Pembrokeshire) to 84.9% (Anglesey) (Table 3). MenB vaccination was introduced in September 2015 for those born 1st May 2015 onwards, therefore infants turning 1 year of age in April 2016 would not have been eligible [2]. Excluding those who were not eligible, uptake of two doses was 87.4%.
- 7. Uptake of one dose of MMR⁶ by two years of age remained stable this year at 95.1% compared to 95.3% in the previous year. Uptake ranged by HB from 93.8% (Hywel Dda University HB) to 96.1% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 93.4% (Pembrokeshire) to 97.1% (Monmouthshire). Four HBs achieved the target uptake of 95% for one dose of MMR by two years of age, and 15 out of 22 LAs exceeded the 95% target (Figures 1, 4 and 7 and Tables 2, 4).
- 8. Annual uptake of the final dose of Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCVf) by two years of age was 95.4%. Uptake by HB ranged from 94.3% (Hywel Dda University HB) to 96.4% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 93.3% (Newport) to 97.0% (Anglesey) (Figure 2 and Tables 2, 4).
- 9. Annual uptake of the Hib/MenC⁷ booster by two years of age was 94.5%, ranging by HB from 93.3% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 96.0% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 91.8% (Newport) to 96.5% (Anglesey) (Figures 1, 2 and Tables 2, 4).
- 10. Coverage of the Hib/MenC booster in children by the time of their fourth birthday was 93.3% and ranged by HB from 91.0% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 95.2% (Cwm Taf University HB) (Table 5).
- 11. This year, coverage of the '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV⁸ pre-school booster in children by four years of age was 87.9%, this ranged by HB from 83.4% (Aneurin Bevan University HB) to 91.8% (Betsi Cadwaladr University HB) (Table 5).
- 12. Coverage of a complete two dose course of MMR vaccine in children by four years of age was 86.4%, this ranged by HB from 82.1% (Aneurin Bevan University HB) to 89.9% (Abertawe Bro Morgannwg University HB) (Table 5).
- 13. The proportion of children who were up to date with their Hib/MenC booster, '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV pre-school booster and MMR vaccines by four years of age was 84.6%, a 0.7% decrease from 85.3%, in 2015/16 (Figure 3 and Tables 1, 2 and 5). This ranged by HB from 80.7% (Aneurin Bevan University HB) to 88.3% (Betsi Cadwaladr University HB) and by LA from 77.6% (Newport) to 90.9% (Anglesey).

MenB vaccination was introduced in July 2015 and all infants reaching 1 year of age from 1st May 2016 onwards would have been eligible. Three doses of MenB vaccine should be given at 2, 4 and 12-13 months of age.

- **14.** Annual uptake of two doses of MMR in children at five years of age was 90.3% this year, compared to 91.6% last year (Figures 1, 5, 8, Tables 2, 6), ranging by HB from 87.7% (Powys Teaching HB) to 92.4% (Cwm Taf University HB). Coverage of one dose of MMR in children at five years of age was 96.7% and ranged by HB from 95.1% (Powys Teaching HB) to 97.8% (Cwm Taf University HB).
- **15.** Uptake of the '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV pre-school booster in children reaching their fifth birthday this year was stable at 92.5%, compared to 92.1% in the previous year (Figures 5, 9, Tables 2, 6).
- 16. Coverage of one dose of HPV vaccine in girls in the 2016/17 School Year 9 (reaching their 14th birthday between 01/09/16 and 31/08/17) was 86.7%, ranging by HB from 75.6% (Powys Teaching HB) to 91.6% (Abertawe Bro Morgannwg University HB) and by LA from 75.6% (Powys) to 92.8% (Bridgend) (Table 7). This is the second School Year 9 group to be offered the two dose course and uptake of one dose is slightly lower compared to the uptake reported for the 2015/16 School Year 9 group in the previous annual COVER report (89.6%) [3]. Coverage of two doses of HPV vaccine in girls in the 2016/17 School Year 10 is currently 85.8%.
- 17. Coverage of two doses of MMR in teenagers turning 15 years of age between 01/09/16 and 31/08/17 was 87.4% (Table 8), ranging by HB from 82.3% (Powys Teaching HB) to 90.5% (Betsi Cadwaladr University HB) and by LA from 78.6% (Monmouthshire) to 93.5% (Wrexham). Coverage of one dose of MMR in 15 year olds was 92.6%, ranging by LA from 84.8% (Monmouthshire) to 96.2% (Caerphilly). A breakdown by sex indicates that 88.1% of girls had received a full (two MMR doses) course of immunisation against rubella this year and coverage of only one dose was 93.0%.
- **18.** National uptake of the Td/IPV⁹ teenage booster in children reaching 15 years of age between 01/09/16 and 31/08/17 was 82.7% (Table 8). Uptake ranged by HB from 72.7% (Cardiff and Vale University HB) to 91.0% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 70.3% (Cardiff) to 91.3% (Rhondda Cynon Taff).
- 19. The routine teenage MenACWY vaccination was introduced at the start of the 2015/16 school year replacing the single antigen meningococcal C teenage booster that was previously given to children in School Year 9 [4]. Coverage in the in the 2016-17 School Year 10 group, the first Year 9 routine cohort to be offered the new vaccine is currently 80.0% (Table 8).
- 20. Coverage of two doses of MMR in teenagers turning 16 years of age between 01/09/16 and 31/08/17 was 88.9% (Table 9), ranging by HB from 84.0% (Powys Teaching HB) to 90.5% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 82.4% (Monmouthshire) to 92.5% (Caerphilly). Coverage of one dose of MMR in 16 year olds was 93.8%, ranging by LA from 87.8% (Monmouthshire) to 97.0% (Caerphilly). A breakdown by sex indicates that 89.5% of girls had received a full (two MMR doses) course of immunisation against rubella this year and coverage of only one dose was 94.1%.
- 21. National uptake of the Td/IPV teenage booster in children reaching 16 years of age between 01/09/16 and 31/08/17 was 84.2% (Table 9). Uptake ranged by HB from 77.9% (Powys Teaching HB) to 91.1% (Cwm Taf University HB) and by LA from 75.5% (Monmouthshire) to 92.0% (Merthyr Tydfil).
- 22. Uptake of hepatitis B immunisation, extracted from the Public Health Wales All Wales Neonatal Hepatitis B immunisation database, is presented in Table 11. The data show very high levels of immunisation in these infants at very high risk of hepatitis B infection. The database was developed to assist the Public Health Wales Health Protection Team in the monitoring and follow up of hepatitis B immunisation of babies born to hepatitis B positive mothers and to provide a source for statistics on uptake of hepatitis B immunisation in this

group. Uptake of three doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their first birthday in the year ending 31st March 2017 was 94.3%. Uptake of four doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their second birthday in the year ending 31st March 2017 was 89.7%. Uptake of four doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their fifth birthday in the year ending 31st March 2017 was 100%.

Inequalities in uptake of routine vaccinations at four years of age

The relationship between deprivation and uptake was examined. The percentage of children who were up to date with their routine vaccinations by four years of age is presented broken down by Health Board and the national quintile of deprivation of the Lower Super Output Area (LSOA) in which the children reside (Figure 11 and Table 10). National quintiles of deprivation were calculated according to the LSOA rankings contained in the Welsh Index of Multiple Deprivation (WIMD 2014). For the data presented here, quintile five represents the most deprived quintile of LSOA and quintile one represents the least deprived quintile of LSOA. Deprivation rankings contained in the WIMD are relative, not absolute values and they refer to an overall composite measure of factors related to deprivation for all residents in the LSOA as a whole, not the circumstances of individual residents within the LSOA.

Nationally, the percentage of children up to date with their routine immunisations by four years of age ranged from 81.0% in the most deprived quintile of LSOAs to 87.0% in the least deprived quintile of LSOAs (Figure 11 and Table 10). The difference in uptake between the least deprived quintile and the most deprived quintile was 6.0%, a decrease from 7.2% in 2015/16 and 6.7% in 2014/15 (Figure 11).

Comment

During 2016/17 uptake of the '5 in 1' and pneumococcal conjugate vaccines remained above 95% in children aged one year of age and uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine increased to 94% from 93% in the previous year.

For the first time, this report contains MenB immunisation uptake figures for children reaching their first birthday, following the introduction of this vaccine on 1st September 2015 [2]. Uptake of two doses in eligible infants, born 1st May 2015 to 31st March 2016, which includes a period covering the introduction of the vaccine and a small catch up cohort receiving the vaccine slightly older than routinely scheduled, was 87%. In comparison uptake of routinely scheduled MenB vaccine in the first quarter of 2017 was 96.1% for two doses [4]. This is encouraging and suggests high levels of acceptability of this recent addition to the childhood vaccination schedule.

In 2016 it was announced that the infant MenC vaccine given at 3 months of age would be removed from the schedule following a successful MenC programme resulting in the virtual disappearance of invasive meningococcal group C disease in Wales [1]. The one year old children in this report were the last cohort to be offered the vaccine. The MenACWY vaccination for teenagers continues.

The proportion of children who are up to date with their routine immunisations by four years of age has decreased again this year, for the third year in a row. Only one local authority area achieved 90%. Of all the immunisations that are included in this composite measure, uptake of the second dose of MMR saw the largest decrease (1.3%) followed by the Hib/MenC booster (0.8%). Uptake of the '4 in 1' preschool booster remained stable.

The inequality gap in immunisation coverage between four year olds residing in the most and least deprived areas decreased compared to 2015/16, but remained higher than the 5% gap reported in 2013/14. Decreases in uptake by four years of age were seen in children living in the most deprived and the least deprived areas of Wales. The smaller inequality gap in uptake reported here is explained by the decrease in uptake in the least deprived quintile being larger than the decrease seen in the most deprived quintile.

Uptake of two doses of MMR in 5 year olds has decreased again this year, following a trend first seen in the previous annual COVER report. This is of concern, and increases the risk of outbreaks of measles. Coverage of one dose of MMR in 5 year olds is more stable.

This report provides complete uptake figures for the first routine group of girls to be offered a two dose course of HPV vaccination following the change in the HPV vaccination programme in September 2014 [3]. Uptake of two doses of HPV in this group was 86%, the same uptake as reported for three doses of vaccine in the last cohort to complete the three dose schedule in 2016.

During the 2015/16 financial year the single antigen MenC (meningococcal group C) vaccine was replaced with MenACWY vaccine in teenagers, with a phased catch-up campaign [5]. Uptake in the first routine cohort of teenagers receiving the Men ACWY vaccine (reaching 15 years of age in 2016/17) was 80%, whilst uptake in the first catch up cohort (reaching 17 years of age in 2016/17) was 78% [4]. Uptake in those vaccinated through General Practice (aged 18, 19 and 20), is lower at 27%, 37% and 39% as at 15/05/2017 [6]. Teenagers reaching 14 and 16 years age are being vaccinated during the current academic year, dates of vaccination session vary throughout the year by region and progress is reported in the quarterly COVER reports [4].

Uptake of one dose of MMR in 15 and 16 year olds was below the 95% target this year, and less than 90% of teenagers received the second dose of MMR. This is a cause for concern. During the summer of 2016 there was an outbreak of measles in the UK associated with attendance at music festivals [7]. There has also been an increase cases across Europe [8]. To ensure that future outbreaks are avoided, implementing existing policy guidance and checking and ensuring that children and teenagers in Wales have received two doses MMR remains a key priority.





Figure 2. Summary of uptake rates for selected immunisations in resident children reaching their 1st, 2nd and 5th birthday between 01/04/2016 and 31/03/2017 and resident on 31/03/2017.¹⁰






Figure 5. (a) Uptake of two doses of MMR vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 5th birthday between 01/04/16 and 31/03/17. **(b)** Uptake of 4 in 1 vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 5th birthday between 01/04/16 and 31/03/17.




Figure 6. Annual uptake of 5 in 1 vaccine by 1 year of age (2013 – 2017 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2016/17).




Figure 7. Annual uptake of 1 dose of MMR by 2 years of age (2013 – 2017 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2016/17).




Figure 8. Annual uptake of 2 doses of MMR by 5 years of age (2013 – 2017 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2016/17).




Figure 9. Annual uptake of the '4 in 1' pre-school booster by 5 years of age (2013 – 2017 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2016/17).




Figure 10. Percentage of children who are up to date with routine immunisations ¹² by four years of age, by quintile of deprivation of the Lower Super Output Area in which they reside. Vaccine uptake is presented for children reaching their 4th birthday between 01/04/2016 and 31/03/2017 and resident on 31/03/2017.





Figure 11. Percentage of children who are up to date with routine immunisations by four years of age during 2012-2017 financial years, by quintile of deprivation of the Lower Super Output Area in which they reside.
