



Key points

- For children at one year of age in Wales, uptake of all routine immunisations, apart from rotavirus, remained above 95% this quarter. Uptake of three doses of the "6 in 1" vaccine was 95% or higher in six of the seven Health Boards (HB) and in 20 of 22 Local Authority (LA) areas.
- Uptake of the complete three-dose course of MenB vaccine in two year olds was 94.0% this quarter. Three HBs and six LA areas had an uptake above 95%.
- Uptake of the first dose of MMR vaccine in two year old children was 94.5% this quarter. Four HBs and 10 LA areas achieved an uptake of 95% or over.
- The proportion of children up to date with all routine immunisations by four years of age was 88.7% this quarter and was 90.8% in five year olds.
- HPV vaccination has now been introduced as part of the routine schedule for school year 8 boys. Uptake of one dose of HPV vaccine in the 2019-20 school year 8 children (12-13 year olds) is currently 0.1% and will increase over the next three quarters as vaccination sessions take place.
- Uptake of routine MenACWY vaccine in the 2019-20 school year 9 cohort is 12.0%, this will increase in coming months as more vaccination sessions take place. Coverage of the MenACWY vaccine in the 2019-20 school year 10 cohort was 84.6%.
- Uptake of the Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2019-20 school year 9 cohort is 12.4%. Coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2019-20 school year 10 was 84.5%.
- Coverage of one dose of MMR vaccine in the 2019-20 school year 10 (age 14-15 years) was 95.3%, coverage of two doses was 91.6%.
- Coverage of one dose of MMR vaccine in the 2019-20 school year 11 (age 15-16 years) was 95.1%, coverage of two doses was 91.5%.

Background

These results are for children living in Wales in December 2019 and reaching their first, second, fourth, fifth and 16th birthdays during the quarter 01/10/2019 to 31/12/2019. Uptake of key immunisations in older children, which are mainly provided through school based programmes in all areas other than Cardiff and Vale University Health Board, are presented in school year cohorts (children reaching their 14th, 15th and 16th birthdays between 01/09/2019 and 31/08/2020). BCG immunisation uptake data are also presented here for children vaccinated selectively following risk assessment. Coverage of neonatal hepatitis B immunisation in infants at risk is also presented, using data from the Public Health Wales Neonatal Hepatitis B database. MenACWY conjugate vaccine uptake figures for teenagers and young adults born from 01/09/1996 to 31/08/1999, vaccinated as part of the general practice-based catch-up campaign are available from:

Public Health Wales Vaccine Preventable Disease Programme and Communicable Disease Surveillance Centre, working with Powys Teaching Health Board and the NHS Wales Informatics Service, carried out a COVER data quality assurance project in 2018. This project has led to improvements in completeness of vaccination data in the national COVER dataset. The impact is that reported vaccination uptake has increased; primarily in children aged four years and older. National trends in this report for 2015 – 2018 are updated to take into account these changes.

Findings

1. Uptake of all three doses of the combined “6 in 1” DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB¹ vaccine, scheduled at two, three and four months of age, in children reaching their first birthday was 95.9% this quarter, compared to 95.4% last quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 93.9% (Cardiff and Vale) to 97.2% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 93.4% (Cardiff) to 99.3% (Anglesey). Six of the seven HBs and 20 of the 22 LA areas achieved the target 95% uptake (Figures 2, 3 and 6, Tables 2 and 3).
2. Uptake of a complete two dose primary course of pneumococcal conjugate vaccination (PCV2) in children reaching their first birthday increased to 96.1% this quarter compared to 95.5% last quarter, and ranged by LA from 93.5% (Cardiff) to 98.7% (Anglesey and Rhondda Cynon Taf). Six of the seven HBs and 21 of the 22 LA areas achieved the target 95% uptake (Figures 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 3).
3. Uptake of two doses of MenB vaccine, scheduled at two and four months of age, in children reaching their first birthday was 95.9% this quarter. Uptake in HBs ranged from 93.4% (Cardiff and Vale) to 97.8% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and ranged by LA from 92.9% (Cardiff) to 98.7% (Anglesey) (Figure 3, Tables 2 and 3).
4. Uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine in children reaching their first birthday increased slightly to 93.9% this quarter. Uptake in HBs ranged from 91.6% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.1% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and ranged by LA from 89.1% (Torfaen) to 96.8% (Merthyr Tydfil) (Figures 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 3).
5. Uptake of the first dose of MMR² in children reaching their second birthday (scheduled at 12 to 13 months of age) remains stable at 94.5% this quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 91.7% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.3% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA area from 90.3% (Ceredigion) to 98.0% (Anglesey). Four HBs and 10 LA areas achieved the target of 95% uptake (Figures 2, 3 and 7, Tables 2 and 4).
6. Uptake of the complete three dose course of MenB vaccine in children reaching their second birthday was 94.0% this quarter compared to 93.9% last quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 90.6% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.0% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 89.9% (Cardiff) to 97.5% (Caerphilly). Three of the seven HBs and six of the 22 LA areas achieved the target 95% uptake (Figures 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 4).
7. Uptake of the final dose of Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCVf, scheduled at 12 to 13 months of age) in children reaching their second birthday remained stable at 94.6% this quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 91.9% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.3% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and ranged by LA from 91.4% (Cardiff) to 98.4% (Caerphilly). Three HBs and eight LA areas achieved an uptake of 95% or over (Figure 3, Tables 2 and 4).
8. Uptake of the Hib/MenC booster (given at 12 to 13 months of age) in children reaching two years of age increased to 94.3% this quarter compared to 94.1% last quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 91.7% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.0% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg), and ranged by LA from 91.2% (Cardiff) to 98.0% (Anglesey). Three HBs and five LA areas achieved uptakes in excess of 95% (Figures 1, 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 4).
9. In children reaching four years of age this quarter (Table 5), uptake of:
 - The “4 in 1” DTaP/IPV³ pre-school booster was 90.2%
 - The Hib/MenC booster was 95.4%
 - Two doses of MMR was 89.7%

¹ DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB vaccine protects against Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (Whooping Cough), Polio, Hib and Hep B infection.

² MMR protects against measles, mumps and rubella infections.

The proportion of children who were up to date with all these routine immunisations at four years of age was 88.7%. This ranged by HB from 86.6% (Aneurin Bevan) to 91.4% (Betsi Cadwaladr) and by LA from 81.8% (Blaenau Gwent) to 94.9% (Anglesey) (Figures 4 and 5, Tables 1, 2 and 5).

10. The proportion of children who were up to date with routine immunisations by their fifth birthday remained stable at 90.8% this quarter. This ranged by HB from 89.5% (Aneurin Bevan) to 92.4% (Betsi Cadwaladr) (Table 6).
11. In children reaching five years of age this quarter, coverage of one dose of MMR was 96.6%. Coverage of two doses of MMR was 92.3%. Coverage of two doses of MMR ranged by HB from 91.2% (Aneurin Bevan) to 93.7% (Betsi Cadwaladr) and by LA from 89.2% (Newport) to 95.5% (Merthyr Tydfil) (Figures 1, 2, 3 and 8, Tables 2, 6 and 7).
12. Uptake of the “4 in 1” DTaP/IPV³ pre-school booster in children reaching their fifth birthday was 92.9% this quarter, ranging by HB from 92.0% (Swansea Bay) to 94.5% (Betsi Cadwaladr) and by LA from 90.5% (Newport) to 96.0% (Merthyr Tydfil). Three of the 22 LAs achieved the 95% uptake target (Figure 3 and 9, Tables 2, 6 and 7).
13. Uptake of the first dose of HPV vaccine for children in the 2019-20 school year 8 group (turning 13 years of age during 01/09/19 to 31/08/20) is currently 0.1%. This is the first time uptake has been reported for boys after the extension of the HPV vaccination programme (Table 8) [1]. Timings of school vaccination sessions vary throughout the year and uptake will increase as vaccination sessions take place over the next three quarters.
14. Coverage of the first dose of HPV vaccine in the 2019-20 school year 9 is currently 86.1% and uptake of the second dose in this age group is currently 3.0%. Timings of school vaccination sessions vary throughout the year and uptake will increase as vaccination sessions take place over the next three quarters. Coverage of a complete two dose course of HPV vaccine in 2019-20 school year 10 girls (girls reaching their 15th birthday during 01/09/19 to 31/08/20) is currently 81.3% (Table 9).
15. Current uptake of the MenACWY vaccine in the 2019-20 routine school year 9 cohort is 12.0% and will increase over the next three quarters as vaccination sessions take place (Table 10 and 11). Coverage in the 2019-20 school years 10, 11 and 12, is currently 84.6%, 85.6% and 85.2% respectively (Table 10).
16. Uptake of the Td/IPV⁴ teenage booster in the 2019-20 school year 9 (children reaching 14 years of age) is currently 12.4%. Coverage of two doses of MMR in this year group is currently 91.4% and coverage of one dose is 95.1%. Coverage of two doses of MMR vaccine ranged by HB from 88.7% (Cardiff and Vale) to 92.8% (Aneurin Bevan). Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 14 year old girls in this school year group was 91.7% (Table 11).
17. Coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2019-20 school year 10 (children reaching 15 years of age) is currently 84.5%. Coverage ranged by HB from 76.1% (Cardiff and Vale) to 91.8% (Swansea Bay). Coverage of two doses of MMR in this year group was 91.6% and coverage of one dose was 95.3%. Coverage of two doses of MMR vaccine ranged by HB from 89.2% (Powys) to 93.5% (Aneurin Bevan). Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 15 year old girls in this school year group was 92.0% (Table 12).
18. Coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2019-20 school year 11 (children reaching 16 years of age) is currently 85.3%. Coverage ranged by HB from 77.9% (Cardiff and Vale) to 90.6% (Swansea Bay). Coverage of two doses of MMR in this year group was 91.5% and coverage of one dose was 95.1%. Coverage of two doses of MMR vaccine ranged by HB from 88.4% (Cardiff & Vale) to 93.4% (Aneurin Bevan). Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 16 year old girls in this school year group was 91.9% (Table 13).

- 19.** Coverage of two doses of MMR in children reaching 16 years of age this quarter (between 1st October 2019 and 31st December 2019) was 91.1%, whilst coverage of one dose of MMR was 95.2%. Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 16 year old girls was 91.4%. National coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in children reaching 16 years of age this quarter was 85.4% (Figures 1, 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 14).
- 20.** Uptake of BCG immunisation is presented in Table 15. These data are based on BCG immunisations recorded in the National Community Child Health Database. BCG immunisation has been received by 4.6%, 6.5%, 7.7% and 5.0% of children reaching their first, second, fifth and 16th birthdays (respectively) during quarter four of 2019. This quarter Newport LA had the highest proportion of children given BCG by one year of age (18.1%) and Cardiff LA by two years of age (19.2%).⁵
- 21.** Uptake data for hepatitis B immunisation in children who were at risk of perinatal infection, extracted from the Public Health Wales All Wales Neonatal Hepatitis B Immunisation Database, is presented in Table 16. This quarter uptake of three doses of hepatitis B vaccine at their first birthday was 91.7%, uptake of four doses⁶ at their second birthday was 66.7% and uptake of four doses at their fifth birthday was 82.4%. Proportions should be interpreted with caution as small numbers of babies require an enhanced course of hepatitis B immunisation.

⁵ BCG protects against tuberculosis infection. Numbers of eligible children for BCG are not known.

⁶ Uptake of the forth dose refers to uptake of the monovalent hepatitis B vaccine due at one year of age. Two year olds in this report were eligible for the “6 in 1” vaccine that replaced the “5 in 1” vaccine in August 2017. These children would have received two doses of monovalent hepatitis B vaccine followed by three doses of DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB and one dose of monovalent vaccine at one year of age to ensure protection against Hepatitis B infection.

Comment

Uptake of the complete three-dose course of “6 in 1” vaccine remains above 95%. Uptake of all other routine primary immunisations in infants reaching their first birthday this quarter also remain at 95% or higher, excluding rotavirus (which cannot be given beyond 24 weeks of age, so is not possible to ‘catch up’).

Uptake of immunisations measured at two years of age was slightly below 95% this quarter, of which uptake of the third scheduled dose of meningococcal group B vaccine was lowest and uptake of the final pneumococcal conjugate vaccine was the highest. Uptake of the first MMR dose in two years olds was stable and just below 95%.

Although uptake of routine vaccinations in the youngest children remains high and stable, uptake in toddlers and older children is lower and wide geographic variation is apparent. There is a gradual downward trend in uptake at 1 and 2 years of age, apparent in all childhood vaccines since 2013, which is also seen in other UK countries.

There was an increase in mumps notifications in Wales in 2019, and this has continued into 2020. The highest number of cases have been in 16 to 30 year olds, although cases have been confirmed in all age groups. Week 48 of 2019 (week commencing 25th November) saw 251 mumps notifications, the highest number of weekly notifications in over 10 years [2]. In 2019, most notifications were reported to Cardiff or Swansea Health Protection Teams; however in 2020 notifications have been more widespread across Wales.

Two doses of MMR vaccine remains the most effective way of protecting against mumps and follow-up of those who have not received scheduled MMR remains key. Coverage of two doses of MMR vaccine remains suboptimal in older children and teenagers and declines with age; uptake was 91.5% in 16 year olds during the 2018-19 school year in Wales [3]. In addition to ensuring catch-up of toddlers and school-aged children, it is important that young adults who have previously missed out on MMR vaccinations are offered catch-up.

A [Measles and Rubella Elimination Action Plan 2019-2021](#) for Wales was published in September, and contains recommendations and actions to improve and maintain vaccine uptake and ensure continued elimination of measles and rubella in Wales, and control of mumps [4]. During 2019 a total of 13,207 cases of measles were reported across 28 EU/EEA Member States with 10 deaths [5]. This is an increased number of cases compared to 2018. There were eleven confirmed cases of measles in Wales in 2019 (provisional data); with three small clusters and number of sporadic cases.

This is the first report to include the uptake of HPV vaccine for boys following the extension of the HPV vaccination programme from the beginning of the academic year starting September 2019 [1]. Small numbers of both girls and boys have been vaccinated so far in this school year; timings of school vaccination sessions vary throughout the year and uptake will increase as vaccination sessions take place over the next three quarters.



The data was sourced from Community Child Health databases maintained by local Child Health Office staff in Trusts throughout Wales based on regular returns from nurses and doctors who immunise or advise on immunisation. Uptake data presented throughout are for HB resident population, not for HB GP practice populations. The maps, graphs, tables 1 and 2 are best viewed in colour.

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Figure 1. Percentage uptake of childhood immunisations in Wales, quarter 1 1997 to quarter 4 2019*.






Figure 4. Percentage uptake of resident children reaching their 4th birthday between 01/10/19 and 31/12/19 and are up to date with all scheduled vaccines⁷ by health board.






Figure 7. Uptake of at least one dose of MMR immunisation in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 2nd birthday between 01/10/19 and 31/12/19.




Figure 8. Uptake of two doses of MMR vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 5th birthday between 01/10/19 and 31/12/19.




Figure 9. Uptake of "4 in 1" vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 5th birthday between 01/10/19 and 31/12/19.


