



COVID-19 vaccination schedule

Individuals not at greater risk of serious disease from COVID-19 infection



Individuals who are at greater risk of serious disease from COVID-19 infection³



¹3rd dose is advised if the person was severely immunocompromised at the time of first or second dose (refer to green book for details)

- ² The priming dose of Moderna Spikevax[®] COVID-19 Vaccine is 100 micrograms (0.5mL), The booster dose is 50 micrograms (0.25mL)
- ³ Health care, social care or care home staff, clinical risk groups, and those who are severely immunosuppressed or their household contacts
- ⁴ This interval may be reduced to 8 weeks in periods of high incidence or where there was concern about vaccine effectiveness
- ⁵ Vaxzevria should only be used in exceptional circumstances
- ⁶Children aged 5 to 11 should receive two 10µg doses of Comirnaty®▼ (Children 5-11yrs) (PfizerBioNTech)
- ⁷ In Spring 2022 an additional booster will be offered to adults aged 75 years and over; residents in a care home for older adults and individuals aged 12 years and over who are immunosuppressed, as defined in the Green Book
